Three from Seppi



Lamberhurst Engineering has added three new machines to the Seppi marque it distributes. The 35 and 45cm wide standard SMO XTR is designed to mow and weed simultaneously to a depth of 4cm, a disc on the base of the mower limiting penetration to avoid root damage. The weeder is fitted to the right side of the mower.

The SMO XTR can be fitted with a hydraulic drive endless belt cross conveyor at the rear to take the grass to the right to deposit it under trees and vines as a means of conserving moisture. Drive is taken from the tractor's external supply.

On the XSA in-row weeder the weeding units are free to float up and down; if greater adjustment is needed hydraulic angling can be fitted. A touch bar activates the spring-release or optional hydraulic breakaway. A disc under the blades controls the depth. The XSA is offered with one or two units on a three-point linkage mounted frame, or a single unit mounted on the side of an SMO mower. The width of the complete unit is adjustable hydraulically, with power supplied by an independent pto-driven hydraulic system.
